RULE 62 REDRESS

Question A

On the last day of a stage, a yacht receives serious damage through no fault of her own and cannot race her second race that day.

- (a) Does “the schedule for the start of the next stage” mean the calendar day the stage is scheduled to start?
- (b) Can the Jury order her race sailed the following day before the scheduled start of the next stage?

Answer A

- (a) Yes.
- (b) No.

Question B

On the last day of a stage, a yacht receives serious damage through no fault of her own and the Measurement Committee decides she can no longer race on that day or on the following day. Can her races scheduled the next day (which is the first day of the next stage) be delayed to another day in that stage?

Answer B

Yes, to the extent permitted in rule 64.2.
